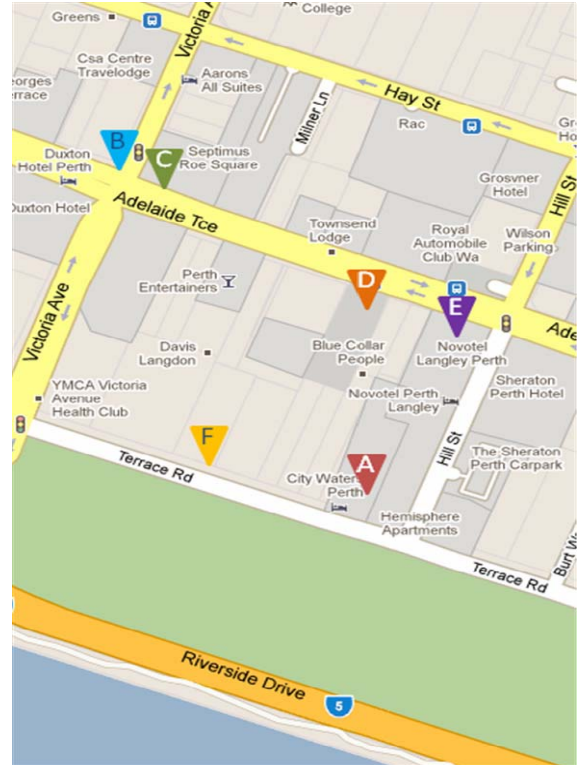

Conference finishes at 5.15 pm

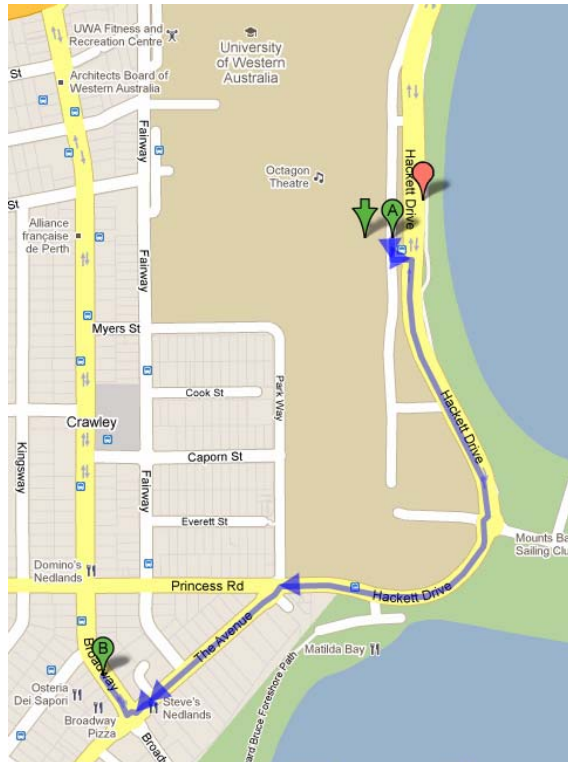
Drinks: 5.15 – 6.30pm (University Bar and Cafe)
